- b. <u>Maintenance</u>: The Association shall be responsible for the exclusive management and control of the Common Areas and all improvements located thereon.
- c. Owner's Easement of Enjoyment: Section 1. Every owner shall have a right and easement of enjoyment in and to the Common Area which shall be appurtenant to and shall pass with the title to every Lot, subject to the following provisions:
- (1) the right of the Association to, upon the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members, dedicate or transfer all or any part of the Common Area to any public agency, authority, or utility for such purposes subject to such conditions as may be agreed to by the Association.
- (2) the right of the Association to impose regulations for the use and enjoyment of the Common Area and improvements thereon, which regulations may further restrict the use of the Common Area.
- Section 2. Any Owner may delegate, in accordance with the By-Laws, his right of enjoyment to the Common Area and facilities to the members of his family, his tenants, or contract purchasers who reside on the property. Recreational facilities, if any, situated upon the Properties may be utilized by guests of Owners or tenants subject to the rules and regulations of the Association governing said use and as established by its Board of Directors.
- d. <u>Restriction on Alienation</u>: Notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, the Association shall not alienate in any way or transfer all or any part of the Common Areas without the prior approval of all holders of outstanding first priority mortgages against any of the Properties that are subject to this Declaration; provided, however, this restriction shall not be applicable to grants of easements for utilities, storm sewer, sanitary sewer, road right of ways and other conveyances for dedication to the public.

5. Association: Membership and Voting Rights:

- a. Every Owner of a Lot shall be a member of the Association. Membership shall be appurtenant to and may not be separated from ownership of any Lot which is subject to assessment.
 - b. The Association shall have two classes of voting membership:
- Class I: Class I members shall be all Owners with the exception of the Declarant and shall be entitled to one vote for each Lot owned. When more than one person holds an interest in any Lot, all such persons shall be members. The vote for such Lot shall be exercised as they among themselves determine, but in no event shall more than one (1) vote be cast with respect to any Lot.
